Hire a car to explore go Island hopping and choose from a range of activities including the [To Sua Ocean Trench](#) accessed via a long ladder (or from a daring jump off the ladder), the turquoise waterhole/lava tube cave offers an out-of-this-world swimming experience. Experience [Papaseea Sliding Rocks](#) (natural water slides) and lose yourself in the tropical [Falealupo Rainforest Reserve](#). The "Taga Blowholes" are another must-see. When sea water is pushed through the cavernous lavas stone, fountains as high

as 60 meters can be witnessed. Lava formations made by nature are impressive, even without water fountains shooting into the skies.

Relax on the Beach

Amongst the number of unbelievably idyllic beaches, you can relax on [Lalomanu Beach](#), named one of the ten most beautiful beaches in the world; the perfect spot to go back to basic, soak up the sun or watch the starry skies with its' breathtaking views of the Pacific Ocean and the scenic mountains of Upolu. Or why not opt for a traditional beach front accommodation and spend the night in one of Samoa's beach fales. An overnight stay in these local huts offers a unique experience to fall asleep under the stars and share the life of the local villagers.
